Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store hiring just four individuals. Overall sales for that particular year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different components. Within five years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide makers within the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business possibilities. During the past sixty years, the material handling trade has grown into a very complex field and Cascade has proudly played a part in this growth. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the premier supplier of forklift accessories and different related items. The company feels assured in their ability so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the global market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to make, design, and sell its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in 1956, in order to house all plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty staff and sales had reached nearly two million three hundred thousand dollars.

A second manufacturing plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry when the business recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are fabricated worldwide thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in forks.
